

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS / INVITATION TO BID

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for the work entitled:

**Contract No.: 2016-09
2017 Sewer and Waterline Rehabilitation Project**

will be received by the of City of Pittsburg at the Office of the City Clerk, 65 Civic Avenue, First Floor, Pittsburg, California until **April 22, 2020 at 2:00 PM** at which time they will be opened and read aloud.

The project requires the reconstruction of domestic water and sanitary sewer facilities including excavation, disposal of hazardous and non-hazardous material, installation of pipelines, reconstruction of manholes, asphalt concrete paving, slurry seal; reconstruction of concrete curbs, gutters, driveways, and sidewalks; traffic delineation and other items of work as shown on the project plans and as directed by the Engineer.

Engineer’s Estimate: Location 3 - Base Bid: **\$7,359,220**
 Location 1 - Base Bid: **\$400,431**
 Location 2 – Additive Bid A: **\$1,650,514**

Attention is directed to the provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code concerning the licensing of Contractors. The Contractor shall possess a California Class A General Engineering or Class C-34 Pipeline Contractor’s License. The Contractor shall perform with his own organization Contract work amounting to not less than 30 percent of the original total contract price.

The contractor is responsible to inspect the site of the proposed work to ascertain a satisfactory understating of the existing actual site conditions. There will be no pre-bid meeting.

The successful bidder shall furnish a bond for labor and materials and performance.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wage rates are set forth in the books issued for bidding purposes entitled "Proposal and Contract", and in copies of said book that may be examined at the offices described above where project plans, specifications, special provisions, and proposal forms may be seen. These wage rates are also available at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/PWD/index.htm> The Director's prevailing wage determinations shall not be below the California minimum wage. Pursuant to Section 1720.9 to the Labor Code, prevailing wage rates shall be paid to haulers of ready-mixed concrete. Addenda to modify wage rates, if necessary, will be issued to holders of "Proposal and Contract" books. Future effective general prevailing wage rates that have been predetermined and are on file with the California Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in the general prevailing wage rates.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, a Contractor may (upon request and at its sole expense) substitute securities for any moneys withheld by the City to ensure performance of the work of this Contract. Any such substitution shall be in strict accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300.

Project Labor Agreement: Per City of Pittsburg Resolution 18-13546 this project is subject to a Project Stabilization Agreement (PSA) and Side Letter in accordance with the City of Pittsburg Local Purchasing Policy. The PSA and Side Letter have been provided for reference in this bid package as Appendix "F".

This project is subject to the provisions of Resolution No. 93-8022 of the City of Pittsburg City Council encouraging the utilization and hiring of local contractors, local business and members of the City's minority community.

Each bidder, and any subcontractor listed in a bid proposal pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 4104, must be currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work consistent with Labor Code section 1725.5, except in limited circumstances as referenced in Labor Code section 1771.1(a). This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

For a Contract proposal to be considered valid, it must be submitted on the forms furnished by the City of Pittsburg in a sealed envelope. The envelope must be clearly marked on outside as follows:

All proposals must be accompanied by either a certified or cashier's check, or a corporate security bond (in the prescribed form) made payable to the City of Pittsburg in an amount equal to at least ten (10) percent of the amount bid. Said guaranty shall be forfeited should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract with the City within the time prescribed in the proposal requirements.

The City Council of the City of Pittsburg reserves the right to reject any or all bids and the right to waive any minor irregularity or informality in the Contract Proposal.
