Future Build is a Pittsburgh Power Company owned and controlled job training program administered by staff and consultants.

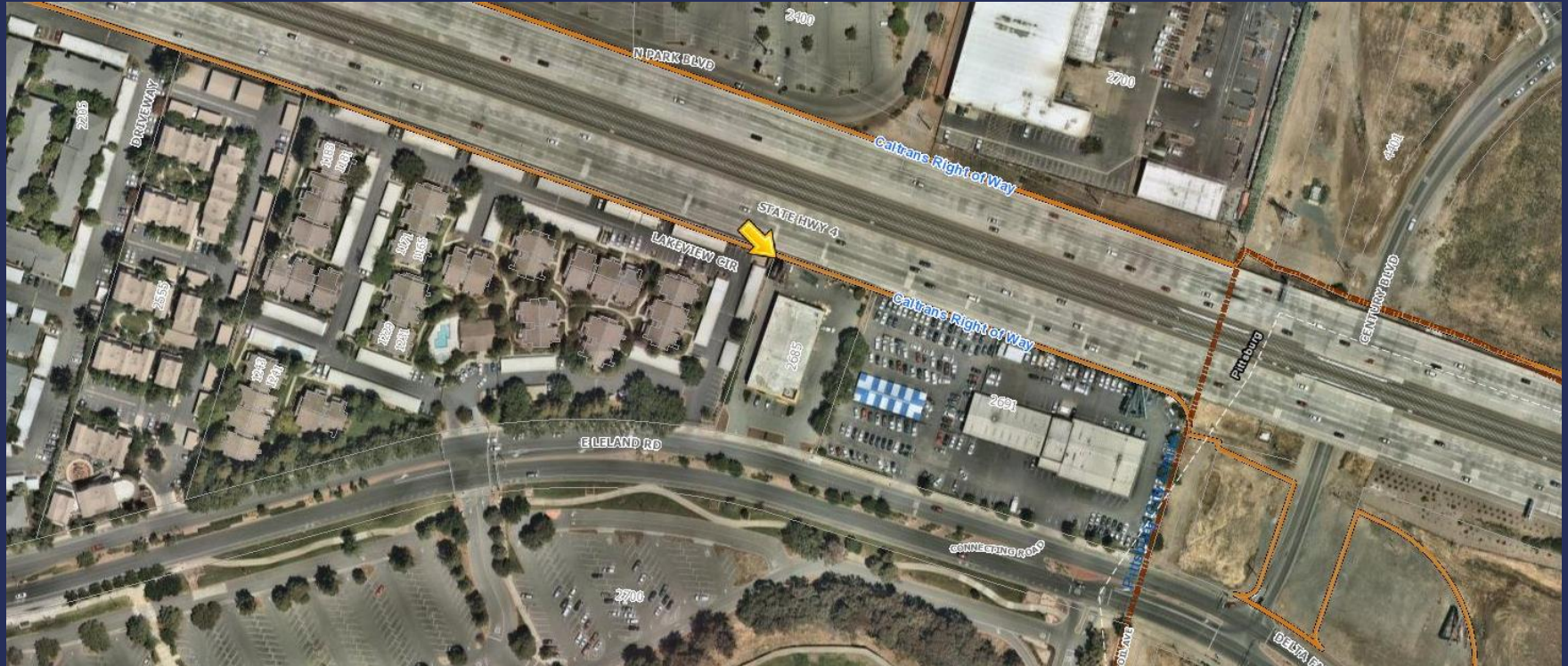

- License Agreement executed 04/15/13
- Expires in 20 years (04/15/33)
- Lease Payment
 - \$25,000 minimum annual guarantee (MAG)
 - 10% of annual gross revenue (less MAG)
- Section 7. Advertising Rights

CARES Act Grant



- East Bay EDA preparing application
- Requesting up to \$9,000,000
- Strengthen manufacturing, transportation, logistics, other industries
- Focus on regional cluster development to support manufacturing at multiple levels

CARES Act Grant



- Grow regional partnerships
- Support startups, maker spaces, spinoff businesses, smaller-scale R&D
- Regional mapping to support supply chains
- Targeted assistance
- Workforce development
- Repositioning opportunities
- Supply/demand inventory
- Potential land use planning
