## NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION CANDIDATE GUIDELINES FOR ISSUING AND SUBMITTING NOMINATION PAPERS

The nomination period for candidates seeking election to the City Council on November 3, 2020 opens on July 13 and runs through August 7. Due to continuing social distancing protocols, we will be scheduling appointments for candidates interested in taking out nomination papers, and we are discouraging folks from simply walking in for service. Please contact me or Deputy City Clerk Amanda McVey by email at [aevenson@ci.pittsburg.ca.us](mailto:aevenson@ci.pittsburg.ca.us) or [amcvey@ci.pittsburg.ca.us](mailto:amcvey@ci.pittsburg.ca.us) to schedule an appointment. We have blocked out both morning and afternoon appointments to be able to accommodate everyone. The office is closed from noon to 1:00 pm. Once you schedule your appointment, you will come into City Hall at the appointed time and meet with the City Clerk and staff. Masks or facial coverings are required when entering City Hall until further notice.

Because the paperwork to run for Council must be personally signed and cannot be accepted electronically, those with appointments will meet in person with the City Clerk and staff. Social distancing protocol will be practiced during your time in City Hall. Once a candidate is ready to file nomination papers, appointments will be required for in-person filing.

If you are interested in running for office, please complete the attached [Application Form](#) and return it to Amanda or me prior to your appointment time. This will enable us to verify your voter registration status before your appointment. This form was designed and is only used by our office and is not an official Elections document, but only used to collect certain information for our records and verification of voter registration. This is the only form that will be accepted electronically.
