Dear Mr. Strello:

I would like to add the following point to San Francisco Community Power's (SF Power) already submitted comments on the above-cited DEIR:

- (3) *The draft EIR omits mention of the project's high potential of inducing another unavoidable adverse impact – loss of shoreline access. It is quite likely that development of the TBC will act to permanently wall-off portions of the Pier 70 shoreline which might otherwise be developed as a pedestrian walkway, bike trail, or other recreational use. This impact is particularly notable given the City and County of San Francisco's long-term plan to develop Pier 70 as a mixed use resource that includes significant shoreline activities.*
